Co Chair Report

We would like to formally introduce Sebastian to our School – sorry you ran away too quickly last meeting for us to get a chance to do so! We are really hoping 3rd time is a charm and that we get to welcome you permanently to our School!

In November, we drew for our winner of our Fall Rafflebox 50/50 for the Playground. This Raised \$7150!! Our winner won \$3575 and donated \$500 directly to our Parks Foundation Account. With fees paid and winner paid – our profits were \$2788.66 (From the Raffle itself but with the donation \$3288.66!!)

Mom's Pantry, Growing Smiles and Purdy's all were fantastic fundraisers! Purdy's was the highest in sales yet! We want to thank Lacey and her army for really working hard to get all 3 of the fundraisers all handed out on the same day! Don't worry if you didn't pick up your Purdy's yet – there will be a team handing the remaining orders out on the Original date of Dec 11th from 3-5pm at the main doors.

The Playground Team ordered the Playground Equipment – the deposit for this is 40% of the overall cost but we are thankful we were able to order this prior to the newest price increase. The team is hard at sending out grant requests and we are so incredibly lucky to have this team working round the clock for these grants!

Treasury

Casino account is currently sitting at: \$209,055.59.

There will however be \$182,029.09 that will come out of this account in the next weeks due to placing a deposit down for our park.

Once this comes out the account will be left with \$27,026.50.

We earned \$1.72 in interest this month.

Operating account is Currently at: \$32,205.35

We earned \$0.22 in interest this month.

Added \$66.03 for ongoing Mables labels fundraiser, HH added 1,528.93 so far for this month, school sweaters added about \$300 or so this is ongoing.

We also completed out 50/50 we after fees etc. we added \$2788.66.

Fundraising

It's been a really great fundraising season. Thank you to all of our dalhousie families who have supported all three of these fundraisers, Purdys, chocolates, growing smiles, and mom's Pantry Yesterday we distributed almost all of the fundraisers, and it was overwhelming with all of the support we received from our families. It was very exciting to be able to participate in handing out all of various products. And it was a great way to finish up the year of 2023. We are looking forward to other fundraisers in the new year.

Playground

Exciting news! The order for the playground is now confirmed, and we've taken the necessary step of issuing the deposit cheque. Nothing can hold us back now! Our school is well on its way to welcoming a new playground by next year. Although our position on the construction list is currently 8th, the prospect of warm weather works in our favor, considering the initial schedule for April or May 2024 remains feasible.

As of now, our confirmed funding stands at \$278,152. With pending funding factored in, our total reaches \$409,000, leaving us approximately \$68,000 away from reaching our goal. Despite facing some challenges in securing grants, the committee has been diligently engaged in grant writing throughout the past month. While we may not have been fortunate recipients of several available grants, our partnership with Park's n Play Design, the playground provider, comes with additional support. They have connected us with experienced grant writers, and we've already initiated the planning process set to unfold in January.
